Dear Parent Council,

We have been noticing that more students are struggling with regulation during recess. While some students enjoy traditional sports, many others are left without meaningful options, which can sometimes lead to frustration and behavioural challenges. We are hoping that by providing a wider variety of recess choices, students will have more opportunities to engage in positive, inclusive play.

Our goals are to:

- Support student regulation and well-being
- Minimize behavioural concerns during recess
- Provide options for non-athletic students
- Encourage creativity, cooperation, and problem solving
- Promote positive social interactions

To help with organization and ease of use, we are hoping to purchase colour-coded materials. These would allow each classroom or grade level to quickly identify their equipment and help maintain organization and accountability.
